Term 1:

Religion, Values and Ethics

Students evaluate the complexities that religious traditions experience when they are seeking to solve the ethical dilemma for example ethics and technology.

Term 2:

Religion, Values and Ethics

Students explore the ethical issues and underlying frameworks applicable to asylum seekers and refugees while including the religious traditions voice in the discussion.

Terms 3 and 4:

Ultimate Questions

Students explore ways societies and cultures express their religious beliefs in diverse ways, particularly with regard to beliefs on ultimate questions about living, suffering, dying and destiny, origins of humankind and the universe. Beliefs from Buddhism, Hinduism, Islam, Judaism and Christianity will be investigated.
